As this week's Advent candle calls us toward a Peace that is rooted in safety, welcome, and faithful companionship, we lift up the work of BIJAN. BIJAN is a community network of individuals, faith communities, and activist groups working to reduce the escalating harm of our immigration system. They provide court accompaniment, legal referrals, and fundraising support to immigrants and asylum seekers. They also offer rides to visit detained loved ones, and help with housing, transportation, and other immediate needs for those released on bond without resources. Old South is giving BIJAN \$10,000 to help support them as they continue building peace by ensuring no one faces the immigration system alone.
